Using appropriate music, costuming and choreography, A Time to Dance teaches accurate dance technique that is at the proper maturation level of the dancer. A Time to Dance caters to the whole student – spiritually, emotionally, mentally and physically, in an atmosphere that glorifies God.

A Time to Dance offers more affordable classes, low student to teacher ratios and Christian instructors who have dedicated their lives to Christ and are constantly educating themselves in the fields of dance, first aid and child development.

Our theme for this semester is “God’s Army.” Homework will include Bible verses to memorize, volunteer projects, pages to color and illustrate and much, much more!

To register, please fill out a registration form. Please include a valid email address, as this is our primary form of communication. Updates will be sent out almost weekly, as well as prayer requests. If you have a prayer request, please email them to mbuck@firstbaptistraytown.com and they will be passed on.

Spring fees may be paid several ways. First, the total fees may be divided into two payments that can be made by cash or check, made out to Celebration Academy of the Arts. Second, payment can be made by automatic withdrawal from your checking account. This needs to be set up through the A Time to Dance office and divides the total payment into 5 withdrawals, taken on January 20th, February 20th, March 20th, April 20th and May 20th. Third, fees may be paid by credit card online at firstbaptistraytown.com/schools/CATA. This system has given us trouble in the past, so if you find this is the case, please call the ATTD office and we will assist you in setting this up.

Multiple students and multiple student families may take \$15 off the second class and/or student. A \$10 late fee will be added for payment arrangements not begun by January 30th.

To prepare at home for recitals and performances, music CD’s of our recital music are made available for \$1.

No underwear is to be worn under the tights.

No jewelry is to be worn during class time.

Hair needs to be worn away from the face in a ponytail, bun, etc.

Class uniform, including leotard, tights & appropriate shoes, must be worn at each class.

Dancers need to remain quiet and attentive during class.

Disrespect for instructors or fellow dancers will result in dismissal from the class room.
